According to the maxim of "Education is considered philanthropic ", education can only be philanthropic if with the help of it the ability to think and awareness is created and with the help of it man can also earn his livelihood and guide people to the path of life and philanthropy .Education is the third eye of man and its foundation is laid in schools . Accordingly the Chief Khalsa Diwan ,the foremost educational institution of the Sikh community ,felt the need to open a temple of education to provide quality education to the children in the border and rural areas. And along with this special emphasis is laid on an all-round development of children.

Keeping in view the above facts ,on 26th April 1995 Sri Guru Harkrishan Senior Secondary Public School Chabhal was established with 9 students in an area of 3 acres . This school under the smooth and able guidance of various members incharge has been able to come up at the level of one of the best institutions of the area. In which 103 diligent and experienced teachers are teaching 2260 students with dedication and sincerity . Moreover the school is providing an atmosphere that works as a catalyst in making each child a balanced human being having its core strength embedded in the learning experience emanating from our rich-socio culture roots.

Building Infrastructure:-A marvel of modern architecture ,the building contains well –lit airy classrooms ,spacious playground and beautifully landscaped lawns. Apart from the basic necessities which include to keep the campus clean and hygienic at all time ,there are hi-tech computer labs ,smart classrooms with digital boards ,activity room for tiny tots ,well-equipped science labs, English Language lab, Music centre , Dance theatre ,art and Craft room , Multi- purpose hall , AC pre-primary block , lift, dispensary ,basketball court ,handball and volleyball ground . The entire campus is monitored through CCTV cameras . The new Senior block, Seminar Hall, Gurudwara Sahib, boundary of the school are under construction.

<u>Educational achievements :-</u> The progress and hardwork of any organization is determined by its results . The school has always delineated 100% results in 10^{th} and 12^{th} CBSE Board Examination . This year also the highest % age in the 10^{th} board exams was 95% and in 12^{th} 93.4 % in Medical , 96% in Non-Medical , 91.4 % in commerce and 92% in Humanities . Rosenoor Singh Dhillon made the school

proud by getting 100% marks in English Subject .Being the need of hour to update the teaching methodology of the teachers time to time the teachers attend various seminars and workshops online and offline . The school enrolled itself with SAFAL exams started by CBSE . We also started Skill education in class VI, VII, VIII with AI , Block Printing and IT as its subjects.

Sports Achievements:-Sports and games are also an integral part of education and play a major role in creating a healthy society. So special arrangements have been made in school for expert coaches of various sports, under whose able guidance the children increase the pride of the school by participating in various district and state level competitions and attaining high positions. Six (6) of our students bagged gold and silver medals in U-14 and U-17 categories in the 26th and 27th state level Sub -Junior_Taikwond Championship, 14 girl students, were selected for the state – level Kho- Kho and Gatka, from under -14 and under -17 from 'Sports Watan Punjab'. In the previous CKD inter- school sports competitions, the students performed very well and secured many positions. Our Volley Ball, Kho –Kho and Hand ball teams are the winning teams of District Tarn –Taran.

Religious Activities: The initiation of religion starts from birth of man. Therefore, we try to make the children aware of our rich history by imparting secular education as well as religious education in the school. 50 students of the school took the amrit and became guru's disciples in the 'Amritpan' conducted by the Dharma Prachar Committee, Chief Khalsa Diwan on the birth anniversary of Guru Gobind Singh Ji.Giani Sahib Singh Markanda a prominent scholar of the Sikh Community gave a lecture to 35 students of the school along with the meaning of Sahaskirti Bani. 12 students received stipends of 6 thousand from the examination of Religious and Sikh History by the Education Committee Chief Khalsa Diwan. Harmanpreet Singh of Class XII, won the first position in the Gurbani Kanth Competition organized by the Education Committee. In the religious examination conducted by Sikh Missionary College, Ludhiana two students got merit, four students got 'A', five got 'B' and 27 got 'C' grade. We are proud to say that currently 150 students and 10 teachers are doing 'Sahej Path'

<u>Cultural and Other Activities</u>: Children are taught the importance of Special days by celebrating various Gurpurabs, National festivals, Cultural and Social festivals. They are encouraged to participate in various competitions e. g debate competition, Poetry, quiz, calligraphy, Poster making, Henna, Rangoli etc. In the Competition Inter-house, Inter School levels competitive exams conducted by the Science Olympiad Foundation students participated and got prizes. 108 students

got gold medals in Maths ,33 in English ,9 in science ,41 in Social science ,35 in Computer and 5 in Commerce . At National Level Competition organized by 'Rang Utsav' celebration Organization Mumbai ,19 students received gold , 24 children Silver and four received consolation prizes. Eighth class student Manraj singh won the National Silver Trophy.

<u>Social Awareness:-</u> To make the students aware of the current environmental and Social problems various activities are conducted by the Eco Club, Health club and infinity club of the school. The students and teachers of Eco Club and Health club held the rallies to make the people aware of the harmful effects of pollution and Drug addiction. Street plays are also conducted to raise the awareness among the people of the area. To keep the surroundings clean and green trees are planted in the campus by celebrating Tree Plantation Day, Earth Day etc. Through NCC, Scouts and Girl Guides, children are inculcated with good qualities and sense by Patriotism.

<u>Other Achievements</u>: To begin with the greatest achievement for the school is FAP(National Federation of Private Schools and Association of Punjab) Award 22 for the best school in Infrastructure in the State, held at Chandigarh University. Three Teachers of the school are also honored with the Award as a 'Best Teacher Award'. Every year teachers are awarded with 'Best Teacher Award' by Sahodaya and CKD for the outstanding performances in the school.

Today we feel proud to say that our school is progressing by leaps and bounds under the able guidance and support of our respectable members in-charge S. Manjit Singh Dhillon, S. Adarshpinder Singh Maan, S. Ajitpal Singh Aneja and devoted Md. Principal Anureet Bawa and 103 hardworking teachers.
