TURBAN TYING COMPETITION

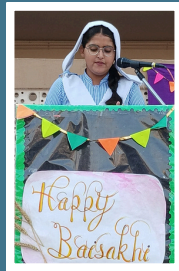

COMMENCEMENT OF TWO-DAY TEACHER TRAINING WORKSHOP AT SCHOOL

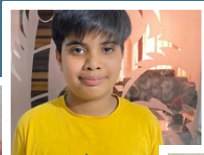
03-04 June, 2024

CELEBRATION OF ENVIRONMENT DAY WITH ENTHUSIASTIC STUDENT PARTICIPATION

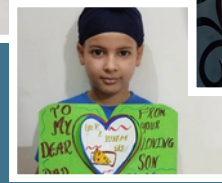
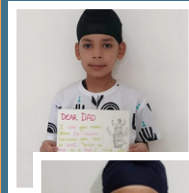
